1. Do you see ripe harvests in your world today? Are you willing for God to send you there, even if it means walking across the street to your neighbor?

2. In section 10:3-16, what are the dangers in this section that Jesus warns his disciples about? Are these different than the ones we face today? If so, what are the differences?

3. Is God's judgment more severe on those who have had the greater opportunity to hear his Word? Who faces severe punishment from God today for not obeying him and carrying out his kingdom mission?

4. Are you sure your name is written in the book of heaven? How do you know?

5. How does one "make" a disciple? Is there a cost involved? Would you describe discipleship as an event or a process? Why?

6. Ask each group member to take moment and think quietly on this question: "What does Jesus want of me, now."?

7. What application principles can you find or make from our passage today?
