1. What is the big picture concept of this book?
2. In Luke's Gospel, is the theme of God's judgment more severe on those who have had the greater opportunity to hear his word? Who faces severe punishment from God today for not obeying him and caring out his kingdom mission?
3. In Luke 11:2-4, in what way do these verses give us a model prayer? A sample prayer? The Lord's prayer? How do you use this in your prayer life?

4. In reviewing Luke chapter 12, in what ways are you ready for Christ to come again? In what ways are you not ready? Why?

5. What group of people today would compare to the Gentiles of Jesus' day? Do you see any way they could be entering the kingdom before you? Why? Why not?

6. What is the cost you must pay to be a disciple of Jesus? What loyalties and relationships have you surrendered to follow and obey Jesus? Are there any excuses that you are presently using not to do the work of the kingdom?

7. What does God want you to do with the principles of truth from this lesson? How can you share the life transforming truth of this lesson this week to those who you encounter?
